## Working in Eurasia

Janice and I work throughout the region of Eurasia:

- It includes 4,000 unreached people groups.

Small wonder that Eurasia makes up a major portion of what's known as the "10-40 window," the least evangelized region of the world.

Think of the strategic value of doing Bible school work there. That's our work.

## Writing

Lately, Dale has been working on a Pentateuch course. This covers the five books of Moses that begin the Bible. It's a basic

course offered in nearly every Bible school in the world. Indeed, it will be widely used, not only throughout Eurasia, but also in other regions as well. *Pray* that Dale will be able to pick up the pace on that project and work much quicker.

Dale also has to write and revise courses that he'll be teaching this Winter and Spring. So, it'll be a balancing act to get everything done.

## Teaching

This Winter, Dale travels to Kathmandu, Nepal to teach Biblical Theology to the BTh students of Nepal Theological College. Doyle Fulkes will be there for a couple weeks to teach and minister too. What a privilege

This Spring, Dale travels to Kiev, Ukraine to teach Old Testament Theology to the MA students of Evangel Theological Seminary. We helped to found ETS in 2000. It's always a pleasure to return there and see it thriving and turning out Gospel ministers, Bible school instructors, and leaders for the Pentecostal churches of the former Soviet Union.
