We can help with assignment of short term instructors. Eurasia's Bible schools rely heavily upon visiting instructors. Instructors who can be available for short periods during breaks or on a sabbatical can serve the Lord in missions. Assignments will range from two weeks to a month and even longer periods when it's possible.

For example, an assignment might involve teaching a one-month block of two courses at a resident Bible college. There you would teach all morning each day and find opportunity to preach in the evenings and on weekends.

Or the assignment might involve teaching seminars for a week or two at an extension training session where pastors and leaders were gathered for continuing education—or perhaps for the only Bible training they have ever had.

I will provide the following services to facilitate your ministry on the field:

- Inform you of teaching opportunities and needs.
- Help you schedule an assignment that will work for you and one of the schools in Eurasia.
- Facilitate your association with and ministry through the Division of Foreign Missions (DFM).
- Provide orientation material about travel, board, and teaching conditions where you will work.
- Provide instructional guidance about unique teaching demands where you will work.
